#### **Donor Advised Funds Awarded for 2010**

The Rochester Area Knights of Columbus Donor Advised Fund Committee is pleased to announce the following contributions for 2010:

A \$12,000 contribution to St. Julian's Coffee House in Rochester: This collaborative effort between all the Catholic parishes in Rochester will provide an environment to comfortably draw non-Catholics and non-practicing Catholics into a relationship with Christ and his Church. The Coffee House will also give Catholics a welcoming space where they can gather to discuss their faith, reflect, pray and grow spiritually. The project is headed by Fr. Matt Fasnacht who is working with the Bishop, the Parishes, a Board of Directors with representation from each Rochester parish and a Board of Trustees who will be financially responsible for paying the lease on the coffee house space. The contribution will complete their minimum funding goal to enable the group to move forward to acquire a site and start construction while they continue their fundraising efforts towards their ultimate goal of raising \$64,000.

A \$3,000 contribution to Gift of Life Transplant House in Rochester: The mission of Gift of Life Transplant House is to provide transplant patients and their caregivers with quality, affordable accommodations in a supportive, home-like atmosphere with others undergoing similar experiences. The House recently celebrated their 25<sup>th</sup> year of operations by completing a new facility to meet growing demand. The contribution will provide furnishings for one of the guest rooms in the new home. The gift will be acknowledged with a plaque recognizing the Knights of Columbus in the room as well as on the recognition wall in the main entrance of the House.

We had several requests from a variety of worthwhile causes. After prayerfully reflecting on all requests and with input from their respective councils, the Committee determined these two requests best fulfilled the intent of the Donor Advised Fund: to provide value driven contributions to support broad based, collaborative efforts to meet local needs consistent with the values of the Knights of Columbus.


As we pray with the Bishop those wonderful words, "May God who has begun this good work in you bring it to fulfillment", one of our own, Deacon Andy Vogel, will come to the fullness of the holy priesthood. Deacon Andy, a former member of Resurrection, will be ordained to the priesthood on June 11, 2010 at Sacred Heart Cathedral in Winona, MN.

Son of William and Mary Kay Vogel, Deacon Andy's journey of faith began at Iowa State University. While he was earning a degree in Computer Science, he also made time to study his faith. As his journey continued, his faith became more and more important to him. After graduation, he moved to Rochester, MN and was employed by the Mayo Clinic as a computer specialist.

He examined some of the local parishes and settled in at The Church of the Resurrection. His journey of faith led him to Fr. Andrew Beerman, a new priest who had just finished his studies in Rome. They became good friends, and Fr. Andrew suggested that Andy get acquainted with
