THE JIM CAMPBELL SCHOLARSHIP FUND provides financial assistance to priests, brothers, seminarians and sisters for continuing education. Past and present State Chaplains have stressed the importance of this program to aid clergy in advanced education programs and ask for an all out effort to increase donations. These funds are distributed on a need basis to all six dioceses to recipients recommended by the Bishops. The program deserves your council's support.
