Dear Mr. Pyfferoen,

I hope that everything is going well for you this summer. My name is Jedidiah Taubel and, until recently, I was a Seminarian for the Diocese of Winona. During that time the Rochester Knights of Columbus councils supported me greatly, and I would like to thank you for your part in that. But I also have something else I would like to say.

Many good and exciting things have been happening in my life lately, and I would like to share some of these with you. As I said above, I was a Seminarian for the Diocese of Winona until this past February when I left the program to further discern my call before moving on. I then graduated from Saint Mary's University in May and decided to join **FOCUS**: The Fellowship of Catholic University Students, a collegiate missionary group. So, for the next few weeks, I will train alongside more than 400 other new staff, as we prepare for our wonderful mission.

Let me back up a bit though. During my time in Seminary, I grew to know and love Christ and the Catholic faith in a very real and deep way. Through this love, I was being challenged to grow in many ways, particularly in my concern for my fellow men and women. Chief among these concerns was that they would come to know the same joy that I had found in this deeper life of faith.

This desire to share the joy of my faith was heightened through my interactions with my peers. I met many people who had no joy at all, people who were hurt and used by one another, without knowing why they were hurting all the time. They seemed to have little hope and merely went through life without a sense of purpose, they were not really living life to the full. I began to wonder how I could spread the fire of faith to these brothers and sisters of mine.

This is exactly why FOCUS exists: to build relationships with students and introduce them to Jesus Christ and His Church, empowering them to do the same for others. As a full-time campus missionary, I will reach out to students by leading Bible studies and mentoring them one-on-one.

As you can imagine, I am excited but nervous as I take this leap of faith. There will be thousands of freshmen converging upon campus this August, and I want to be there to be God's ambassador to them and to help lead them to Christ. This is the greatest challenge I've ever faced, and I am trusting God with this venture, but I also realize that I need help!

I have been praying and thinking of key individuals who have had a part in my life. Mr. Pyfferoen, I would love the opportunity to share with you my mission with FOCUS and the financial challenge the Lord has laid before me. It would be an honor to get to do that with you when I am back home in July. The faith and dedication of the Knights has always meant a lot to me. I will give you a call the week of June 30th to see when a good time might be to stop by in July.
