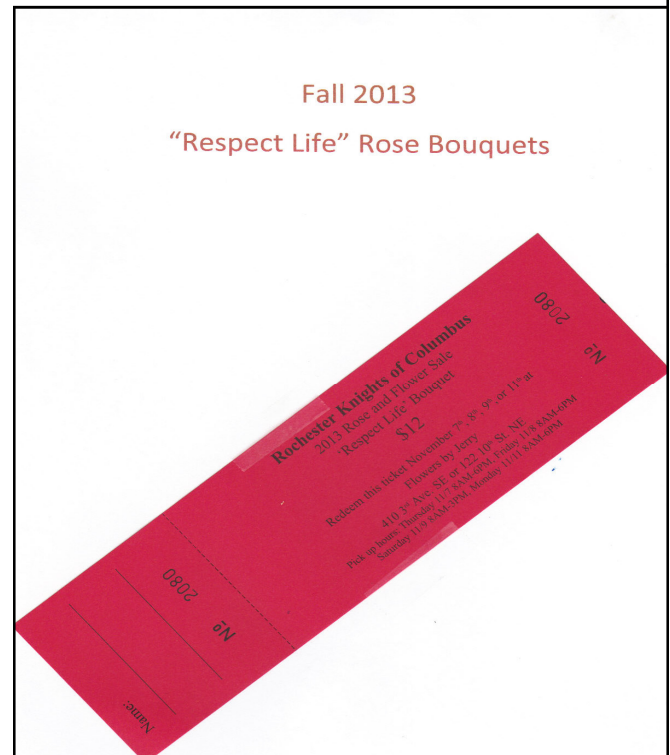

Dear members of the Knights of Columbus,


